Dr. Maríte Tísa Letter from Latvía

Dear Brothers and Sísters in FLMI Family

We send sincere greetings to you in this Christmas time when we remember the birth of Jesus on this earth and look forward to His second coming as the King of Kings. Praise God for His mercy that "all who did receive Him, to those who believed in His name, He gave the right to become children of God" (John 1:12 KJV). What can be a safer position in this world today as to be a God's child? When a person's spirit is reconciled with God, it is salvation; when a person's soul is reconciled with God, it is deliverance; when a person's body is reconciled with God, it is healing. Some time ago I wanted to find and read Scriptures about joy and discovered that Jesus Himself is the Joy. What a treasure is Christmas event!

Praise the Lord that He allows FLMI to work in Latvia. Our main ways how we minister to people with your financial and prayer support is soup kitchens in several places – Kandava, Talsi, Sabile and Ciruli. Other thing is support to children and youth with special needs – cerebral palsy, Down syndrome, cancer, mental retardation, epilepsy and others which includes the wonderful Usma events in summers when our FLMI American Team joins us. Please, be welcome to come and see it for yourself, take part in this ministry – it will give a special experience and spiritual reward to you. We have had a lot of teams

coming from USA earlier, but not lately. There is also work with children in a form of camps in summer and school holidays; counseling families and individuals before marriage and during different problems; leading support groups for women who are in critical periods of life as fighting cancer and other severe sickness for several years; practical help with food and clothing which involves collaboration with grocery shops, organizations and fellow people (sometimes it includes even giving a place where to stay in your own flat for people who do not have where to stay); leading Bible studies; doing music and worship ministry; holding a prayer support and other things.

One of the most active FLMI Latvia Team member is Gita Vadone. Her work is also



recognized from local government and recently we were able to read about her work in our local newspaper. The Food Bank's donation campaign "For a Fed Latvia" has been running for 15 years. This time the traditional food parcel filling campaign took place in 57 stores across Latvia. 65 food parcels were filled in Talsi. Gita, together with volunteers, has been coordinating the food parcel donation campaign since 2016. She also helps with donations on a daily basis. Gita

says that there is currently a very high demand for help and donations. The question is how many people are able to help. The culture of the donors is also important. When spending a day in a supermarket, which is not an easy job, to approach people and invite them to donate, we do not always receive a nice attitude in return. We are happy for every product donated, whether it is a whole sack of flour, pasta or one bottle of oil. Most people like to participate in the campaign with their children; older people also donate. Compared to other years, there were not so many products this year, but we must take into account the rise in prices and inflation, which affects people's purchasing capacity. Donated products reach people for whom it is an important support in their daily lives. It is important for everyone to be well-fed, but food especially creates a sense

of belonging for children. Sometimes families thank for providing them with food that they could not have afforded before. Gita and her assistants pack the packages and deliver them to the recipients themselves. However, many need help in the long term, so Gita's heart's work spreads wider. Together with her husband, they are loving parents to a big family and ministers in the church; the family is part of those people who work with Gita in collecting donations and then delivering them to people. This activity in campaign is the visible part of her work; every day, together with volunteers, she collects household items, food, clothes and supports to encourage people and alleviate some of



their daily needs. Gita remembers a moment that remains vivid in her memory. One day, she and her husband were driving past a family's house and decided to visit the family with a food package. They hadn't asked for it, but she knew that the family had many children. They had a feeling that it would be useful for them. When the mother saw the box full of products, she said that their son would now be able to

go to the class excursion with other classmates. It was so important that the family was able to afford to send their child on an excursion.



It is a great joy to see how people who earlier were supported by FLMI now are actively involved in ministry themselves. Artis, the father of little Artis with CP has founded a church in Sabile and is a leader and preacher there. God miraculously provided a place for the church which Artis himself

with helpers repaired (there is still a work to do). And he ministers to the locals who are not so easy to approach by Soup Kitchen, being a soccer coach for young boys, involving in community life and prayers. There is a collaboration with other FLMI Latvia Team members who participate in services with worship music.

We are thankful for God's blessings and that we can be His collaborators. We are thankful that He gives us opportunities and strength to carry out His work. Thank you for support!
